## All's not well with state's education sector: CM

- Govt to set up Meghalaya Education Recruitment Board
- School textbooks to be adapted from NCERT

SHILLONG, Nov 16: Chief Minister Conrad K Sangma on Thursday admitted that all was not well with the education sector in Meghalaya and said that the government was deeply concerned about the same. He said that the state Cabinet has taken some decisions following a series of deliberations with the stakeholders. Prominent among the decisions taken by the Cabinet include the constitution of the Meghalaya Education Recruitment Board (MERB). As there are about 187 vacancies in secondary, higher secondary, and teacher and technical education levels which the vacancies have not been filled in four years, the board would handle the recruitment process and expedite the recruitment process.

The board will be directed to complete the recruitment process within 3 to 6 months. It will also be the overarching body for taking care of recruitment and education-related matters in the state.

The Cabinet further decided to adopt NCERT textbooks in schools with modifications in certain subjects to be carried out by the Meghalaya Board of

Secondary Education.

Sangma said the decision will allow the adaptation of the NCERT textbooks with necessary modifications from classes I to X.

For schools teaching in local or vernacular language (from classes I to V), the necessary changes in language will be done for the adaptation to take place.

Sangma said the process for Phase I will start in the next academic year.

"After consultation and research with many stakeholders in the education system, we concluded that the MBoSE textbooks, especially for mathematics, science and English, are not up to the national standards," he said while adding that the adaptation aims to improve the overall quality of textbooks, learning outcomes, and quality of content, which will also lead to the reduction in the number of textbooks.

"We will also ensure the curriculum is adapted to the national curriculum and have local content based on our culture and history," the CM added.

In insisting that the burden of textbooks will reduce for students following the decision, he said 11 textbooks for classes I, II, and III can be replaced by

four textbooks under NCERT.

"There will be an improvement in the quality of the content to be imparted to the students. It will be in conformity to the requirements at the national level including the learning outcomes," Sangma said.

The Cabinet also emphasised that local contents, based on culture, history, and uniqueness, would not be diluted.

### Fiscal Act amended

The Cabinet also decided to amend the Meghalaya Fiscal Responsibility and Budget Management Act, 2006, following which there will be 0.5% increase in the budget borrowing.

Sangma said the Act was amended last year as per the Union government's decision to allow the states to increase their budget borrowings based on reforms taken by the states on an annual basis.

Last year, Meghalaya's borrowing limit was increased by 4% while this year it has been hiked to 4.5% to allow the state to increase its borrowings by Rs 400 crore.

### Department renamed

In another decision, the Cabinet approved the renaming of the Labour Department as the Department of Labour Employment & Skill Development.

**'Recognition of languages riddled with challenges'**

SHILLONG, Nov 16: Chief Minister Conrad K Sangma on Thursday said the state government is keen to make Khasi and Garo the state's official languages but there are logistical challenges and that aspect is being examined.

"The issue of declaring a language as an official language depends on the definition of official language," he said.

"There are logistical challenges in terms of a simple aspect like if tomorrow the noting of government files is done in Garo language, will that be an issue? How will we handle that? If somebody makes a noting in Garo and suppose, the officer speaks Khasi and English and is not able to make comments or understand, then we will have challenges in the governance process," Sangma explained.

City skywalk project put on hold

SHILLONG, Nov 16: The destruction of an upscale walk from Barik Point to Khyndai Lad was announced by the state government earlier this year with the goal of encouraging people to walk, which will reduce traffic. However, like countless other projects, this one has also been placed on hold.

Chief Minister Conrad K Sangma announced on Thursday that the project was in the implementation phase, but he also cautioned that once construction begins, there would be severe traffic congestion.

As a result, the government has chosen to postpone the project until more plans are clear on the area's traffic up.

The government had earmarked Rs 25 crore to construct the skywalk to connect Barik Point with Khyndai Lad and enhance pedestrian traffic.

## Conrad plays down Shillong LS seat quandary

SHILLONG, Nov 16: Chief Minister Conrad K Sangma on Thursday said the process to hand over the Mukroh firing incident to the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) will be taken up now.

"These are decisions that have to be implemented in full...

The process has to be followed and the process requires both the states to sign the minutes of the meeting. Once the minutes are signed by the chief ministers, only then it is taken as official. The process requires time...even one comma can change the meaning of minutes," Sangma told reporters.

He also said that he and his Assam counterpart Himanta Biswa Sarma have signed the meeting minutes and now, the official process of communicating the same to the commissions concerned and central government will be taken up.

Stating that there are other aspects in the minutes that both states mentioned, Sangma said, "We will see the withdrawal of forces from different states in different areas at a substantial level. I don't want to go into details."

In this regard, he said tensions will go down substantially in sensitive locations.

The CM-level talks between Assam and Meghalaya on the interstate boundary issues had decided to wind up the judicial commission which was instituted to probe the Mukroh firing incident and replace it with an independent inquiry by the CBI. The CBI will register the case at a neutral place other than Guwahati and Shillong to maintain the neutrality of investigation.

Meanwhile, talking about the proposed visit to the border areas, he said, "I am in touch with the Assam CM for our pending visit to Block I and Khanduli Psiar (Contd on P-4)

SHILLONG, Nov 16: NPP national president and Chief Minister Conrad K Sangma on Thursday neither denied nor disagreed with reports that his party has been holding discussions with Trinamool Congress vice-president George B Lyngdoh.

SHILLONG, Nov 16: Normaley is finally expected to return to the North-Eastern Hill University (NEHU) after the Joint Action Committee (JAC), protesting against Vice Chancellor Prabhu Shankar Shukla, decided to end their agitation following a meeting between the two factions on Thursday.

JAC chairman Lakhon Kma announced that the group had decided to temporarily halt its agitations.

He added that the decision was made in response to the VC's request for five days to respond to all of their demands, including the removal of Rohit Prasad from his position as senior consultant and technical officer at the university.

Kma said a decision was taken to form two committees: one to review the educationally underdeveloped areas quota, with a chairman chosen by the students, and another to look into the marking system, hostel accommodations, and health care.

The NEHU Academic Council will choose the chairman and members of the second committee.

In addition, he said, the VC promised to relieve the teaching and non-teaching staff of their ministerial responsibilities and to address the demand for the appointment of university engineers and statutory officers.

The next meeting of the AC is scheduled for the first week of December, during which the majority of these issues will be deliberated and a decision made.

Kma also informed that the university will schedule an annual convocation event and that the VC has also consented to allow students to have a representative on the Academic Council.

## Cabinet approves increase in govt borrowing limit

Shillong, Nov 16: The State Cabinet today approved the amendment of the Meghalaya Fiscal Responsibility and Budget Management Act, 2006 to increase the government's borrowing limit by another 5 per cent.

Addressing media persons after the meeting, Chief Minister Conrad K Sangma said last year also the Act was amended and this was done because the Government of India has allowed different state governments to increase their budget borrowing based on reforms taken by

specific states on an annual basis.

"Last year, the reforms that were taken place by the state government in different departments allowed us to increase our budget borrowing limits up to 4 per cent and this year again, based on the power reforms that we are taking there will be 5 per cent increase in the budget borrowing that is allowed," he said while adding that "annually it has to be amended so the particular Act through an ordinance is being amended today."

Sangma said the bor-

rowing limit will roughly go up to Rs 400 crore.

"Every year it is only 3 per cent but they allow 3 per cent to be increased to 5 and another 5 per cent based on specific reforms that the state government do. So this year we are working with the central government and based on the reforms the adoption is taking place and this 5 per cent additional is allowed to be taken by the state government," he added.

He said that the borrowing limit was approximately Rs 900 crore, last year.

## JAC decides to suspend strike in NEHU

Shillong, Nov 16: The Joint Action Committee (JAC) of the NEHUTA, NEHUNSA and NEHUSU today decided to suspend its indefinite strike after the University's vice chancellor Prof PS Shukla sought five days' time to look into the charter of demands including removal of the technical officer/senior consultant.

After a meeting the VC, JAC chairman Prof Lakshon Kma said, "We have decided to temporarily suspend our agitation and from tomorrow classes will resume, teaching staff can take their respective classes and non-teaching staff can go back to their respective offices."

He said the decision was taken after the VC had requested five days' time to address all demands made by the JAC which includes the termination of Rohit Prasad as a technical

officer/senior consultant of the university.

The meeting was a success although the VC could not provide the official letter of terminating Prasad.

Prof Kma also informed that the VC has agreed to form a committee to address the issue related to the marking system and relating to grievances of the hostel facilities and health care.

"The VC had left it to the students to select a chairman who will head the committee to look into the demand to revisit the marking system of the university," he said.

He added the VC also assured to address the demand to appoint Statutory Officers and University Engineers and to relieve teaching and non-teaching staff from ministerial duties.

On the demand to review the educationally backward areas quota, Prof Kma informed that the VC had agreed to form a committee which will be decided by the AC on its chairman and members.

"The VC had promised the JAC that the next AC meeting will be held in the first week of December


