## Tynsong replaces Kharlukhi as state NPP president

National People's Party (NPP) national vice- president and Deputy Chief Minister Prestone Tynsong on Tuesday was appointed as the state president of the party.

Tynsong is replacing lone Raya-Sabha MP from the state D-WR Bharfalkh, who headed the state unit of the party for 16 years, ahead of the Lok Sabha and Autonomous District Council (ADC) elections.

Tynsong was felicitated by the NPP national president and Chief Minister Conrad K Sangma at a meeting held at the state party office in presence of party leaders and functionaries.

Congratulating Tynsong, Sangma said, "I would like to join the other leaders, who have expressed their joy and happiness on the appointment of Prestone Tynsong (as state president)."



"I have worked with him in many situations and from very difficult positions and large numbers of challenges we have faced together, we have grown together as friends, understanding each other's concerns, problems and working as a team. I am very happy today that he has accepted this responsibility because I know his capacity and I know the kind of work he is capable of doing and I am

sure that he will be taking from where Dr Kharlukhi has now left and he will take forward the mission of the party and I am sure that with the kind of grassroots work that he has done for the last many years, organisationally or from governance point of view – all of these will come into great work and help to be able to really organise the party. I have full faith that he will be able to do justice," he said.

Seeking the support of all party leaders, Sangma said, "I only seek the support of all party leaders, you all know that the demand or request for Prestone Tynsong to take over has come from you so it is not that I have selected. It is ademocratic process. It is just a democratic process. It is just that election did not take place and all the votes came and ev-erybody sent the information and requests – it was literally a democratic process, all the way from Garo Hills to Jaintia Hills to West Khasi Hills to Ri Bhoi in all areas there was a consensus and that clearly reflects the kind of acceptance and the kind of faith that people have in the leadership of Prestone

Tynsong."
The NPP national chief also The NPP national chief also asked Tynsong to reconstitute the state level committee immediately. In his maiden speech as state president, Tynsong assured that reformation of the NPP will immediately take place.

#### Vacancies in police dept to be filled soon

force as per rules.

"We had seen in the past that these recruitments would take quite a long time because of the various rules so we have tried to streamline the rules so that we can ensure that the recruitment process is completed efficiently, transparently in faster possible time. These rules are quite a few but just to summarise these rules are to ensure that the recruitment process for the recruitment process for SI, constables (AB/UB) would be conducted efficiently and taking the least possible time,

To a question, Diengdoh said that there are about 2,500 vacancies in the Police department.
"After these rules are amend-

ed it will be notified and once it is notified the advertisement will be called for these vacan-cies," he added.

The State Cabinet on Tuesday approved the amendment of the Meghalaya Excise Amend-ment Rules, 2021 for reclas-sification of brands to ensure additional revenue of Rs 50 crore is collected by Excise

At present, excise collection is about Rs 350 crore per year. To a question, Commissioner & Secretary in charge of the department, Sanjay Goyal, said the revenue collection of the department during the last five years is around Rs 1,200 crore. "Before Covid the revenue

was hovering around Rs 200
crore and we have got a substantial increase in the last 4-5
years so if you take that into
account I think the average
revenue collected from excise would be roughly 1200 crore but that is the figure I need to confirm."

On the steps taken to increase the revenue generation, Goyal said, "This is one of the major steps as I have mentioned. I have rejigged the

classification of the brands, we have studied the kinds of classification our neighbour-ing states are having and what kind of advantage we can draw in classifying so basically when you classify the brand at certain price law load then

when you classify the brand at certain price level and then the brand of those prices we are imposing the excise duty and with this exercise though the impact on the revenue is roughly 15 per cent the impact on the MRP will not be that much, roughly around 9-10 per cent.

According to him, this rejigging has helped the department to get around 5 per cent additional revenue without impacting on the MRP.

### JAC stops NEHU Academic Council meet State bid to protect fragile ecosystem

The state government is preparing to come up with legislation to protect the fragile ecosystem of Meghalaya while aiming to go for quality tourism and not be just guided by foorfall quantum. Stating that the state is in the process of coming up with a bill to protect the fragile ecosystem of Meghalaya, Tourism Minister Paul Lyngdoh said it will be introduced in the Assembly once ready. Talking to reporters, Lyngdoh said on Tuesday, "More than the foorfall, our emphasis now is high value tourism." He said more than tourist footfall, the government's emphasis is on high value tourism to upscale the quality of visitors than the number of visitors. Asked, he said, the major focus of the bill is to protect the

tourism areas which are fragile and subject to damage if tourist footfall is not controlled.

"That's happening everywhere for instance at Arwa cave, where at a single point of time there were about 200 people entering the cave at the same time creating a lot of about 200 people entering the case at the same time creating a lot of chaos and noise, pollution and a lot of inconvenience where people were pushing each other and that had to be regulated," the minister said. Lyngdoh was addressing the media after a consultative workshop with stakeholders here. Over hundred stakeholders participated in the event which was meant for the Khasi laintiat Hills region.
"The aim today is to look at the pitfalls, the challenges and drawbacks in the present scheme of things. How the government can proactively engage itself and further add value to Meghalaya as a tourism brand," he added.

The HNYF East Khasi Hills unit responded to the arrest by disowning Dkhar and expressing alarm with the first-of-its-kind accusation

## Illegal appointment: JAC up in arms against NEHU VC

SHILLONG, Oct 31: The Kma stated. Joint Action Committee (JAC) consisting of NE-HUTA, NEHUSU, and NE-HUNSA is prepared to step up its protest if NEHU Vice Chancellor Prabha Shankar Shukla does not fire senior consultant and technical officer Rohit Prasad, who was

allegedly recruited illegally. Lakhon Kma, the head of the JAC, stated that they anticipate Prasad to step down on his own.

"But even if he doesn't guit on his own, the JAC will continue to press the VC to end his employment. His office room is now locked. On humanitarian grounds, we

will allow him time to leave the quarter assigned to him,"

The JAC will announce the next phase of agitation if their demand to remove Prasad is not fulfilled, Kma

The NEHU VC has defended Prasad's appointment by stating that all required procedures were followed and that the university's laws and regulations were adhered

"I will be providing all the information, including facts. I will address the media individually to provide clarification on this matter with all the relevant documentation," Shukla continued.

The JAC members had

intensified their agitation against VC earlier in the day by refusing to cooperate, beginning with their absence from the 111th Academic

Council meeting. The academic council meeting was scheduled to take place in the multipurpose convocation hall, which was where the JAC members originally convened.

When they discovered that the VC had moved the academic council meeting to his office conference room, they later staged a procession from the multipurpose convocation hall.

The IAC members burst into the conference room where the AC meeting was scheduled to take place af-

ter congregating at the VC

As the JAC decided to hold its general assembly outside the VC office grounds, the members of the group pushed those who were inside to come out.

The majority of the members complied with the request, but one professor refused to oblige, which forced the other members of the JAC to criticise his choice.

After that, the JAC met outside the VC's office. where leaders discussed the myriad alleged irregularities and crimes the VC is said to have committed.

Earlier in the day, Prasad was encircled by members of the JAC (Contd on P-4)
