Tynsong replaces Kharlukhi as state NPP president

National People's Party (NPP) national vice-president and Deputy Chief Minister Prestone Tynsong on Tuesday was appointed as the state president of the party.

Tynsong is replacing lone Ranva Sabha MP from the state Dr WR Kharlukhi, who headed the state unit of the party for 16 years, ahead of the Lok Sabha and Autonomous District Council (ADC) elections.

Tynsong was felicitated by the NPP national president and Chief Minister Conrad K Sangma at a meeting held at the state party office in presence of party leaders and functionaries.



"I have worked with him in many situations and under very difficult positions and large numbers of challenges we have faced together, we have grown together as friends, understanding each other's concerns, problems and working as a team. I am very happy today that he has accepted this responsibility because I know his capacity and I know the kind of work he is capable of doing and I am

sure that he will be taking from where Dr Kharlukhi has now left and he will take forward the mission of the party and I am sure that with the kind of grassroots work that he has done for the last many years, organisationally or from governance point of view - all of these will come into great work and help to be able to really organise the party. I have full faith that he will be able to do justice," he said.

Seeking the support of all party leaders, Sangma said, "I only seek the support of all party leaders, you all know that the demand or request for Prestone Tynsong to take over has come from you so it is not that I have selected. It is a democratic process. It is just that election did not take place and all the votes came and everybody sent the information and requests - it was literally a democratic process. All the way from Garo Hills to Jaintia Hills to West Khasi Hills to Ri Bhoi in all areas there was a consensus and that clearly reflects the kind of acceptance and the kind of faith that people have in the leadership of Prestone Tynsong."

We will continue to work as family: Kharlukhi

NPP's outgoing state president, WR Kharlukhi has said that the party will continue to work together as a family, and the good work will continue under the new leadership. Speaking to reporters on Tuesday, Kharlukhi said, "It is because of this that we succeeded in coming to power in two terms, and under the leadership of new president Prestone Tynsong we will again come to power in 2028 with absolute majority."

Vacancies in police dept to be filled soon

The state government will soon fill up over 2,500 vacancies in the Police department.

Informing this after a Cabinet meeting on Tuesday, Cabinet minister Marcuse N Marak said, "We have approved the revised uniform guidelines for recruitment of police personnel in Meghalaya Police."

Principal Secretary in-charge Personnel department Cyril Diengdoh said this is the recruitment of all ranks of police, including sub-inspectors, armed branch constables and unarmed branch constables including fireman and Meghalaya Police Radio Organisation (MPRO) operators.

The central recruitment board (CRB) is conducting the recruitment for the police

force as per rules. "We had seen in the past that these recruitments would take quite a long time because of the various rules so we have tried to streamline the rules so that we can ensure that the recruitment process is completed efficiently, transparently in faster possible time. These rules are quite a few but just to summarise these rules are to ensure that the recruitment process for SI, constables (AB/UB) would be conducted efficiently and taking the least possible time," he said.

Excise rules amended to ensure additional revenue

Revenue collection in five years is around Rs 1200 crore: Goyal

The State Cabinet on Tuesday approved the amendment of the Meghalaya Excise Amendment Rules, 2021 for reclassification of brands to ensure additional revenue of Rs 50 crore is collected by Excise department.

Addressing the media, Cabinet Minister Marcuse N Marak said, "There are various brands in our state and we have reclassified (them) for better tax collection. Now, we will have five categories instead of six."

Stating that the excise duty is expected to increase by 15 per cent, Marak said that the state will be getting additional revenue of Rs 50 crore per year.

At present, excise collection is about Rs 350 crore per year. To a question, Commissioner & Secretary in charge of the department, Sanjay Goyal, said the revenue collection of the department during the last five years is around Rs 1,200 crore. "Before Covid the revenue was hovering around Rs 200 crore and we have got a substantial increase in the last 4-5 years so if you take that into account I think the average revenue collected from excise would be roughly 1200 crore but that is the figure I need to confirm."

On the steps taken to increase the revenue generation, Goyal said, "This is one of the major steps as I have mentioned. I have rejigged the classification of the brands, we have studied the kinds of classification our neighbouring states are having and what kind of advantage we can draw in classifying so basically when you classify the brand at certain price level and then the brand of those prices we are imposing the excise duty and with this exercise though the impact on the revenue is roughly 15 per cent the impact on the MRP will not be that much, roughly around 9-10 per cent."

JAC stops NEHU Academic Council meet State bid to protect fragile ecosystem

The Joint Action Committee (JAC) comprising NEHUA, NEHUNSA and NEHUSU on Tuesday stormed and stopped the Academic Council meeting as a mark of protest against the NEHU Vice-Chancellor Prof PS Shukla's failure to terminate the service of a contractual technical officer and non-fulfilment of other demands. After a protest march, leaders of the NEHUA, NEHUNSA and NEHUSU forcefully entered the conference hall in the administrative building where the Academic Council meeting was scheduled to be held and requested all its members to join hands in their protest.

SHILLONG, Oct 31: Bless Dkhar, the president of HNYF East Khasi Hills district, was detained by police on Monday from his Pohkseh home on suspicion of extorting money from overloaded trucks in order to get permission to cross the Umiam Bridge.

Dkhar was allegedly extorting Rs 1,500 for each truck.

The HNYF leader was arrested based on a suo-motu case filed by Laitumkhrak Police after an audio recording surfaced online in which Dkhar can be purportedly heard "brokering" a deal with a "trader" to get his truck past Damsite (Umiam Bridge).

The HNYF East Khasi Hills unit responded to the arrest by disowning Dkhar and expressing alarm with the first-of-its-kind accusation against the group.

Illegal appointment: JAC up in arms against NEHU VC

SHILLONG, Oct 31: The Joint Action Committee (JAC) consisting of NEHUTA, NEHUSU, and NEHUNSA is prepared to step up its protest if NEHU Vice Chancellor Prabha Shankar Shukla does not fire senior consultant and technical officer Rohit Prasad, who was allegedly recruited illegally. Lakhon Kma, the head of the JAC, stated that they anticipate Prasad to step down on his own.

"But even if he doesn't quit on his own, the JAC will continue to press the VC to end his employment. His office room is now locked. On humanitarian grounds, we

will allow him time to leave the quarter assigned to him," Kma stated.

The JAC will announce the next phase of agitation if their demand to remove Prasad is not fulfilled, Kma warned.

The NEHU VC has defended Prasad's appointment by stating that all required procedures were followed and that the university's laws and regulations were adhered to.

"I will be providing all the information, including facts. I will address the media individually to provide clarification on this matter with all the relevant documentation," Shukla continued.

The JAC members had

intensified their agitation against VC earlier in the day by refusing to cooperate, beginning with their absence from the 111th Academic Council meeting.

The academic council meeting was scheduled to take place in the multipurpose convocation hall, which was where the JAC members originally convened.

When they discovered that the VC had moved the academic council meeting to his office conference room, they later staged a procession from the multipurpose convocation hall.

The JAC members burst into the conference room where the AC meeting was scheduled to take place af-

ter congregating at the VC office.

As the JAC decided to hold its general assembly outside the VC office grounds, the members of the group pushed those who were inside to come out.

The majority of the members complied with the request, but one professor refused to oblige, which forced the other members of the JAC to criticise his choice.

After that, the JAC met outside the VC's office, where leaders discussed the myriad alleged irregularities and crimes the VC is said to have committed.

Earlier in the day, Prasad was encircled by members of the JAC. (Contd on P-4)
